



Hunt Test Fees

Entry Fees include a Processing Fee. Entries may be cancelled or changed online prior to close of entry, with refunds (less a Processing Fee per entry and per camping item) available to keep as PerfDog credit, refund to credit card, or mail via check (less a \$3 Check Fee). Entries and camping items may be cancelled online after close of entry, but no refunds will be given.

Running Dogs in Congruent Tests

AKC policy now allows dogs to run congruent in all levels. Dogs can now obtain legs/passes in different levels and work on earning titles at the same time.

Advanced Titles

AKC now has Advanced titles (JHA, SHA, and MHA). A Pointing Breed Hunting Test Advanced title is awarded when a dog passes five additional times with an average qualifying score of 8.0 or higher after earning its initial title in a test level.

Bitches in Season

Bitches in season may compete, but all AKC rules apply. Bitches in season must run at the end of the last level to be judged on the respective field. Please reference the Regulations for AKC Hunting Tests for Pointing Breeds, Amended to December 2012, pages 3 and 4.

Electronic Tracking Collars

Use of AKC Approved Electronic Tracking Collars will be permitted in these tests. All AKC approved tracking devices and the Regulations governing their use may be viewed at – www.akc.org/trackingdevices/. The rules listed on the AKC website will be adhered to. Please be familiar with these rules if you plan to use a tracking collar.

Juniors will run 15 minutes, Master and Senior will run 30 minutes. Tests will run on a single course with bird field.

- Chukar, and/or Quail and/or Pheasants will be released in all stakes.
- Judges and officials will use ATVs.
- Shotguns with NO ammunition will be permitted to be carried by handlers of Master dogs only.
- Blaze orange clothing must be worn by everyone on the course in all tests.

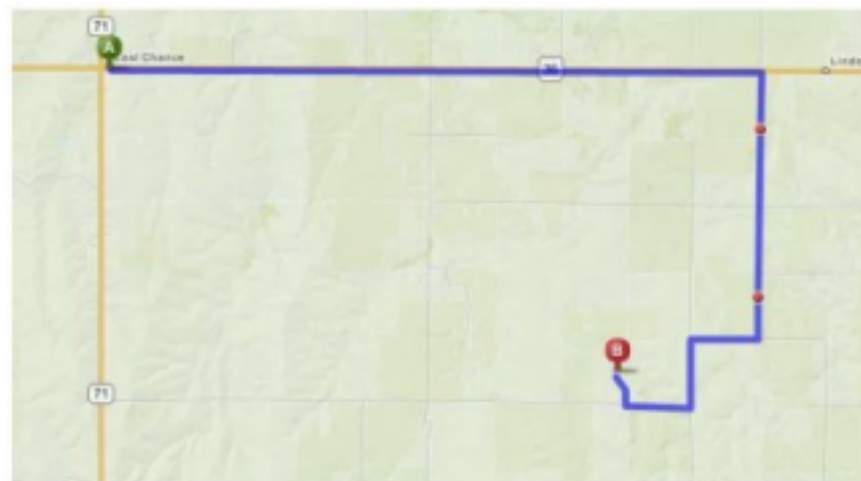

Directions - Lat/Long: 39.674176, 103.448045

- From Highway 36 and 71 (Last Chance, CO)
- Go East, 9.7 miles, toward Lindon, CO.
- Go right (South) on County Road S for 4 miles. (First right hand turn after getting into Lindon)
- Go right (West) on Road 8 for 1 mile.
- Go left (South) on Road R for 1 mile.
- Go right (West) on Road 7 for 1 mile.
- Go right (North) on Road Q for ½ mile. Road Q (is poorly marked and looks like a farm road), It is the entrance to the hunt test area (Ohr Ranch). There are many roads that you can take to the grounds, but for trailers, this is the recommended route.



Conduct On The Grounds

- Dogs are not permitted to be off leash except during the running of their brace.
- During the running of a Hunting Test, there shall be no training on the grounds.
- During the running of a Hunting Test, there shall be no firing of live ammunition, except by the Official Gunners during the test.
- During the running of a Hunting Test, there shall be no firing of blank pistols, except by the handlers during their brace running time. • Please keep in mind that we are guests of Gerry Ohr's Ranch. Pick up after your dogs and yourselves to help preserve the area for our future use—Thank you!
